Diamond Vogel's E-Series Powder Coatings' tightly controlled particle size distribution provides extremely good first-pass transfer efficiencies and edge coverage, along with the smoothest film available. The E-Series Powder Coating exhibits inherent toughness, corrosion resistance, chemical resistance, flexibility, adhesion, and abrasion resistance. Epoxy powder coatings should not be used for exterior applications, as exposure to ultraviolet radiation will cause chalking.



- Recommended cure schedule 10 minutes @ 375°F, peak metal temperature
- Epoxy powder will discolor when exposed to overbake conditions

The cure range for Epoxy Powder Coatings is from 20 minutes at 340°F to 5 minutes at 400°F peak metal temperature.

Film properties are dependent on gloss, pigmentation, film thickness, and cure temperature.

Storage and Handling: Diamond Vogel powder coatings should be stored at normal room temperature and humidity (less than 80°F and 50-60% RH). Shelf life will be approximately six months to over a year depending on storage conditions. Always rotate inventories to ensure trouble-free powder application. When storage conditions are not the same as the application area, allow a 24 hour acclimation period within the application area to prevent moisture condensation in the powder. Always protect virgin and reclaim powder. from excessive heat and humidity.
